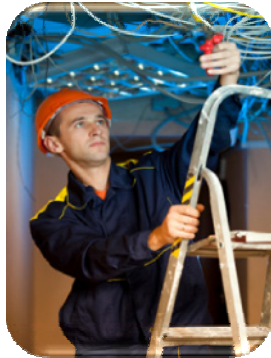

Certificate III in Telecommunications

This course is aimed at electricians and technicians who want to formalise their Telecommunications training into a Qualification. It is also the minimum requirement for a technician to work on Optical Fibre for the National Broadband Network (NBN) soon to start rolling out in Australia

Course Outline:

The course is divided into three logical components allowing a student who has already completed such courses as an 'Open Registration' or any of the endorsement courses to have those qualifications recognised effectively exempting them from resitting those courses again.



The components are:

1. **Prerequisite units** including OHS, Hand and Power Tools and IP Networking the majority of which can be done on line
2. **Licensing** - Open Cabling Registration
3. **Endorsements** - Structured Cabling, Optical Fibre and Coaxial Cabling

So what's available?

1. \$4000 in Commonwealth Government Employer Incentives is now available for this Traineeship— regardless of prior qualifications
2. Tools for Trade payments to the value of \$5500 paid in instalments to the trainee during the term of the training 
3. Support for Adult Australian Apprentices of \$13,000 paid weekly for up to 2 years from commencement date may be applicable for trainees aged 25 years and over.
4. Course is delivered workshop style, at our training centres, with additional content online (e-learning)

Certain conditions and eligibility criteria apply which will be assessed on a case by case basis in conjunction with Integracom.

Advantages to the Employer

1. New staff are trained to a full Certificate III level at no cost to the employer
2. For experienced technicians or electricians the majority of the course can be completed via online and workshop attendance
3. New trainees are part of a 6-12 or 24 month program
